Dimitrios Dimitriou educational background includes Doctorate in econometric modelling for quantitative demand forecasting, MSc in Airport Planning and Management, MSc in Infrastructures Environmental Management, and Diploma (equivalent to 4 years BA and 1-year MSc) in Civil Engineering (transportation sector).
